1. Introduction

4. How We Collect Personal Information

We collect personal information in a variety of ways, including:

If you visit our website, we may use cookies and other tracking technologies to improve your browsing experience and analyse website usage. You can choose to disable cookies through your browser settings; however, this may affect your ability to use certain features of our website.

10. Overseas Disclosure

We generally do not disclose personal information to overseas recipients. However, in some cases, your personal information may be disclosed to overseas service providers (such as cloud storage providers). In such cases, we will take reasonable steps to ensure that the overseas recipient complies with privacy laws that are equivalent to the Australian Privacy Principles.
